The Development Status Report is an important tool that supports informed decision-making and showcases the depth and diversity of development occurring across the region.

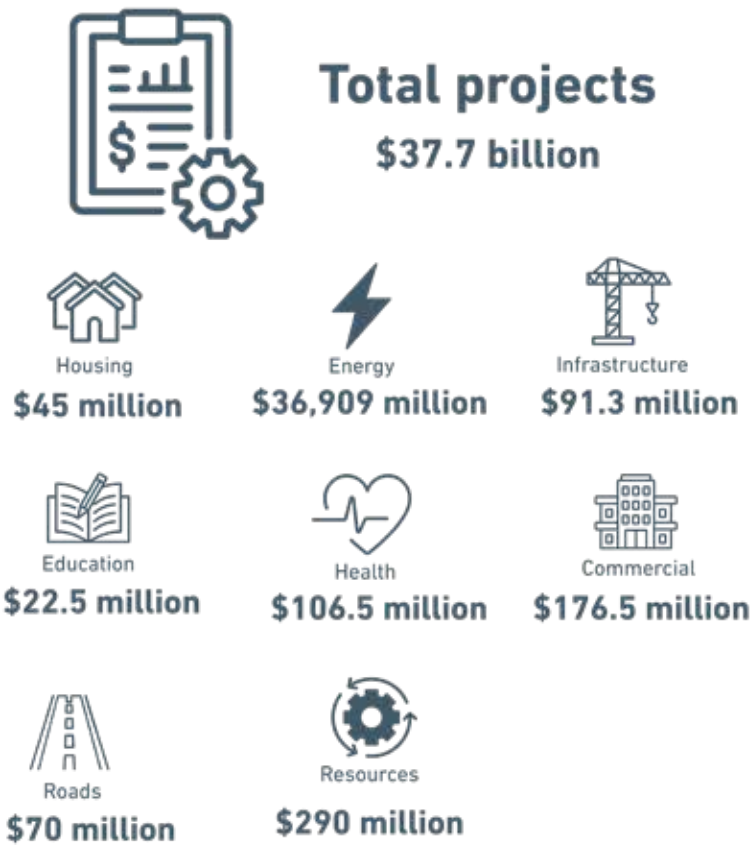
